

COMMONS ACT 2006 – SECTION 15(1)

Notice of an application for the registration of land as a Town or Village Green

To every reputed owner, lessee, tenant or occupier of any part of the land described below, and to all others to whom it may concern.

An application has been made to the Council of the London Borough of Ealing of Town Hall, New Broadway, Ealing, London W5 2DJ under section 15(1) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons (Registration of Town or Village Greens) (Interim Arrangements) (England) Regulations 2007. The application seeks the inclusion in the register of town and village greens of the land described in the Schedule below which is claimed to have qualified for registration as a town or village green on 16th March 2009 by virtue of the land having been common land since at least 1741 and in constant public use as of right for lawful sports and pastimes from that time up to the present time.

The application, which includes a plan of the land proposed for registration may be inspected at the office of the Director of Legal and Democratic Services, Ealing Council, Perceval House, 14-16 Uxbridge Road, Ealing, London W5 2HL between the hours of 9.30am to 4.30pm weekdays (not public holidays) until 15th March 2010.

If the registration authority is satisfied that the land described below qualifies for registration as a town or village green, it will so register the land.

Any person wishing to object to the registration of the land as a town or village green, should send a statement of the facts on which the objection is based to the Director of Legal and Democratic Services, Ealing Council, Perceval House, 14/16 Uxbridge Road, Ealing W5 2HL (Reference: Richard Comben, Tel No: 020 8825 6728) on or before 15th March 2010. Any representations that are to be taken into account by the Authority in reaching a decision on the application cannot be treated as confidential and will be copied to the applicant for comment and may be disclosed to other interested parties.
